IN PERSON PREGNANCY TESTS/COUNSELING

We are currently prioritizing in person visits at our office with PCC team members for those in need of pregnancy tests and pregnancy decision coaching with a particular focus on those who are at risk for considering or pursuing abortion.



CURBSIDE MATERIAL ASSISTANCE

We are able to safely provide material assistance to individuals in need through curbside pick up of essential baby items. Requests are being fulfilled daily and we are thankful we can give out of the abundance that has been provided by our community partners and donors.



VIRTUAL PARENTING LESSONS

We are thankful for technology that allows us to send quality parenting lesson videos and worksheets via email and text message. Our staff work with mothers and fathers to select lessons tailored to their specific needs and interests. Staff are also able to engage in virtual follow up conversations.

GOD KNOWS JUST WHAT WE NEED!

As we live through a set of circumstances that none of us anticipated, we have been blessed to see God's providential care here at the PCC. After the tornado in March, a flood of generous donations made its way into our community. Many of the churches that partner with the PCC were left with more diapers, wipes, and baby supplies than they could handle. They gifted these items to us, knowing that we serve families that could use these items on an ongoing basis. Our building truly could not hold all of the donations we received, but we did not have to worry about where to store them for long! Almost as soon as the items arrived, the need in our community dramatically increased as jobs were lost due to the coronavirus. God knew in advance that we would need more than usual to serve during this time of pandemic, and He provided in advance! As an essential service in our community, we continued to provide services throughout the quarantine, although we have been creative in serving in order to be safe. Another way that we saw God provide in just the nick of time is a new technology that allows us to send our parenting lessons directly to someone's phone. While we prefer to do these lessons face to face, having this tool, coupled with Zoom or phone calls, has allowed us to continue our Parent Support program without risk. As we modified our services to reduce the amount of face-to-face risk we were taking, our greatest concern was if would be able to build the trust and connection needed to minister to women and men who are considering abortion. We praise God for giving us deep connections with people during quarantine- some that we have still only met over the phone! We have been blessed during this strange time to walk with nine new families who have changed their minds about abortion and have chosen life as a result of the support and care we have given them. God is so faithful!

In February we began planning for our first year participating in The Big Payback.

The Big Payback (TBP) is a 24 hour online giving event to support non-profit organizations in Middle TN. When it became evident that our May banquet would not be possible, we were grateful for TBP as a substitute, supplementary fundraiser.
